



When the angle between the ground and the lamp is 65° degrees, the dial points to 0° degrees.








Outer six angle screw

- 50W and 100W: M10 screws
- 150W-280W: M12 screws



Adjustment



Drill holes in the surface where the floodlight will be mounted and install expansion screws.



Ensure that the surface where you plan to mount the floodlight can withstand the weight of the floodlight as well as weather and wind exposure.

Brown = live conductor
Blue = neutral



Warning

- 1. To avoid damage, falling, electric shock or fire, please do not modify the lamp or replace accessories.
- 2. Please authorize only qualified personnel to install the lamp and ensure they follow the instruction manual.
- 3. Any improper installation might cause injury, damage or hazard.
- 4. Please disconnect power before installation or any maintenance of the lamp.
- 5. Please disconnect power if you see smoke or emit odors, since fire or electric shock may occur. Ask qualified personnel to inspect and do maintenance.
- 6. Please do not dismantle the lamp without the supplier's authorization.
- 7. Please do not touch the power supply when the lamp is operating.
- 8. If the external flexible cable cord is damaged, it should only be replaced by the supplier, a service agent or other qualified personnel.

Warranty

- 1. Warranty is 5years (Sea application only 3years warranty). A replacement will be provided during the warranty period if the lamp suffers quality problems. The client is responsible for the costs and control of lamp installation.
- During the warranty period, the client shall send the damaged goods or failed parts
 for inspection and repair after agreement from the supplier. The supplier shall send
 the fixed or new parts back. The sending party shall bear any freight costs
 accordingly.
- 3. Maintenance service will be provided once valid documents are presented.
- 4. The following circumstances will not attract free maintenance:
 - a) Damage caused by human beings, including, but not limited to, damage from abnormal working conditions, improper usage, storage that does not conform to the instruction manual
 - b) Dismantling or modification or improper maintenance or repairing of the products without the supplier's authorization
 - c) Invalid documents
 - d) Damages caused by user's improper delivery, or force majeure including, but not limited to, fire, flood, earthquake.
- 5. The vendor has the sole right to interpretation and amend the above.
